

SharePoint Credit Union Digital Wallet Instructions

Apple Pay

Follow the steps below to setup Apple Pay on your iPhone:

1. Open the Wallet app on your iPhone 6 or later and tap the (+) to add a SharePoint CU card and click continue.
2. Use your digital device's camera to take a picture of the front of your card or enter your card information manually.
3. Verify the name on the card and enter the expiration date and 3-digit CVV security code, which can be found on the back of your SharePoint CU card.
4. Agree to the terms and conditions.
5. To finish, you may be asked to verify your card via text, e-mail, or phone call. This is a normal part of the Apple Pay set up process and does not indicate a problem with your account or card.

Follow the steps below to setup Apple Pay on your Apple Watch:

1. Open the Apple Watch app on your iPhone and tap Wallet & Apple Pay. Then tap Add a new Credit or Debit Card.
2. Use your digital device's camera to take a picture of the front of your card or enter your card information manually.
3. Verify the name on the card and enter the 3-digit CVV security code, which can be found on the back of your SharePoint CU card.
4. To finish, you may be asked to verify your card via text, e-mail, or phone call. This is a normal part of the Apple Pay set up process and does not indicate a problem with your account or card.

Google Wallet

Compatible with any Android smartphone or tablet running Android 4.4 or above

1. Open the Google Wallet App on your device and tap the (+) sign.
2. Use your digital device's camera to take a picture of the front of your card or enter your card information manually.
3. Provide all additional information to verify and activate your card.
4. To finish, you may be asked to verify your card via text, e-mail, or phone call. This is a normal part of the Google Wallet set up process and does not indicate a problem with your account or card.

Samsung Pay

1. Open the Samsung Pay app. When prompted, tap "Add" at the bottom of the screen to access options to add your card.
2. Agree to terms and services.
3. Create a 4-digit Samsung Pay PIN for payment authentication and app protection.
4. Use your digital device's camera to take a picture of the front of your card or enter your card information manually.
5. Verify your card's 3-digit CVV security code which can be found on the back of your SharePoint CU card and your billing zip code.
6. Agree to terms of service.

7. To finish, you may be asked to verify your card via text, e-mail, or phone call. This is a normal part of the Samsung Pay set up process and does not indicate a problem with your account or card.

Garmin Pay

1. Open the Garmin Connect™ Mobile app and access the menu.
2. Select Garmin Devices and select your device.
3. Select Garmin Pay > Create Your Wallet.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions (creating a 4-digit pin and adding your card information)
